## College football rankings today espn

Infographic: Bowled Over The Rose Bowl game, which debuted in 1902, is the oldest bowl game in the country. In 2010, 93,963 people attended. The game has sold out for 63 consecutive years. As recently as the early 1930s, the only major bowl game was the Rose. This season there will be 35. The 34 matches last season were attended by a total of 1.77 million people and saw 225 million on television. The BCS distributed \$155.2 million in revenue from the five major bowl games 2009-2010 to NCAA conferences and independent teams Notre Dame, Army and Navy, with Big Six conferences getting 82% of the pot. In a recent survey, 63% of respondents said they want to replace the system with playoffs. In the same poll, 26% of Republicans surveyed said they are very interested in college football, compared with just 18% of Democrats. Only three of the 32 members of the House Subcommittee on Commerce, Trade and Consumer Protection attended a July hearing at the BCS - the third held in the past two years. 30.8 million viewers watched the 2010 national championship on television, up from 4 million since 2009. The Waterford Crystal trophy given to last year's national champion, Alabama, is worth \$30,000 and toured that included stops at two Walmarks. On average, college football referees are paid \$3,000 per game. The exact salary differs depending on the division, conference and type of game, such as a conference championship or a bowl game. College football referees are paid more per game than referees for other sports, although there are significantly fewer matches within the season each year. Hockey referees, for example, make about \$400 per game teams in Division 1. College basketball referees pay varies, but some can make up to \$2,000 per game. Referees of professional matches, such as the National Football League, can make up to six figures in a season. This team can be found on the school's main campus in Columbus, Ohio, and competes in the Big Ten Conference. Urban Meyer is the current head coach of this team. So far, the team has an all-time record of 878-320-53. 37 conference titles, eight national titles and 10 undefeated seasons, six of these are perfect seasons. The school also produced seven Heisman winners, including Troy Smith, Archie Griffin, and Eddie George. The Buckeyes wear scarlet and grey uniforms, school colors, with the logo printed on the front of the sweaters. These are the same colors that Brutus Buckeye, the mascot in disguise, wears when he makes his appearance on game day. The Buckeyes play games at Ohio Stadium, known as The Horseshoe for fans and students alike. It is located on the OSU campus in Columbus, Ohio and has also been a concert hall for acts such as U2, the Rolling Stones, and more. The Aggies have always worn white and white uniforms with the school logo printed on the right side of helmets. The outline of the state of Texas can also be seen on the left side of the pants with the logo nestled inside. Reveille, the school's live mascot, wears the school's colors. She's a Rough Collie and she's always been historically female. Reveille is the most senior member of the Cadet Corps, which can be found at the school. The team wears the school's colors, the cardinal red and white, with a central stripe and the school logo emced on the helmet. The school's mascot, Bucky Badger, also wears school colors, but opts for a striped sweater with the school logo on front and center. Home games for the Wisconsin Badgers are played at Camp Randall Stadium, which is the oldest stadium in the Big Ten Conference. It is also one of the 50 largest stadiums in the world and has capacity for more than 80,000 fans. The mascot of this school is Dubs, Harry the Husky, a costume mascot who accompanies the team to all games. The team plays all of its home games at The Alaska Airlines Camp at Husky Stadium, which is on campus. Located right next to Lake Washington, the stadium is one of the largest college stadiums in the Pacific Northwest, with a capacity of just over 70,000 people. It is also known as one of the strongest and strongest stadiums in the country, especially when the team faces one of its rivals, including the Washington State Cougars and the Oregon Ducks.
